

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF MAIDSTONE)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON THE FOOTWAY OR VERGE)
(VARIATION No 2) ORDER 2013**

The Kent County Council ("the Council") acting as the local traffic authority in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone) Prohibition of Stopping on the Footway or Verge) (Variation No 2) Order 2013" and shall come into operation on the 26th May 2014.
- 2 In this Order the expression "Order of 2008" means "The Kent County Council (Borough of Maidstone)(Prohibition of Stopping on the Footway or Verge) 2008.
- 3 The Order of 2008 shall have effect as though
 - (i) In The Schedule thereto, the following length of roads are to be inserted in the correct alphabetical sequence.

Chatham Road	Both	From its junction with Moncktons Lane to its junction with Calder Road	At Any Time
Mote Avenue	Both	The Entire Length	At Any Time
Oxford Road	East	From its northern junction with Oxford Gardens for a distance of 74 metres in a northerly direction.	At Any Time
Sutton Road	South-west	From a point 12 metres north-west in line of the building line of No 10 Sutton Road to a point 6.5 metres south-east of the building line of No 86 Sutton Road	At Any Time
Worcester Road	Both	The Entire Length	At Any Time
Poyntell Road (Staplehurst)	Both	The Entire Length	At Any Time
