### Carer Parking Permit Application (Individual)

If you are an individual who requires care and lives within a residents parking scheme, you may apply for your carer to receive a carers parking permit.

An individual carers permit is free of charge. The resident who has a regular carer must be in receipt of higher rate attendance allowance and provide accompanying documentation confirming this benefit entitlement to validate the application.

Carers Permits are only valid in Resident Parking Bays and must be displayed clearly within the front windscreen. Carer's permits do not give concessions for the vehicle to park on yellow line(s), in Maidstone Borough Council Pay & Display car parks or On-Street Pay and Display bays without purchasing a valid ticket.
