MC	Ward: Headcorn Parish: Headcorn	Headcorn Village Hall	2736	(Acting) Returning Officer's proposals: To use Headcorn Baptist Church, as the hall allocated for our use as a polling place at the village hall is too small for use as a double station. The electorate has increased since the last review from 2691 to 2736 and will continue to rise due to the development within the area. The church is more central, has car parking and disabled access
UA/UC/ UX	Ward: Parkwood	Christchurch Hall	2249/ 321/ 1247	(Acting) Returning Officer's proposals: There are currently three polling stations within the Christchurch Hall polling place. It is proposed to move polling district UC to Langley Park School as it is a distance to travel to Wallis Avenue and the existing polling place. Although the electorate is small at the moment the numbers will increase as the development at Langley is ongoing.
V	Ward: Shepway North	Red Cross Centre	1187	(Acting) Returning Officer's proposals: The Red Cross Centre is currently being used for an equipment storage facility and is not available for use as a polling place. Greenfields Community Primary School will be used for the May Election 2019 and if no other buildings are found and are suitable for use as a polling station it is proposed to continue using the school.
