

PLANNING APPLICATION: 20/502238/FULL

Additional representation has been received from a local resident, a Mr Bart Tarry, raising concerns over the following (summarised) matters:

- Questions who the occupant will be of the proposed mobile homes.

RESPONSE: The committee report clearly sets out who is to occupy the mobile homes and what their relationship is with each other. This information was gathered during a site meeting with the applicant on 28th July 2020.

- Alleges by default he and his wife are being harassed and victimised.

RESPONSE: Such allegations should be reported to Kent police for investigate.

- Alleges site access to Neverend Lodge is owned by him and not the applicant:

RESPONSE: The applicant has signed Ownership Certificate A and there is no evidence submitted to suggest that this is incorrect.

- The development does not benefit from a safe access because it is not in the ownership of the applicant.

RESPONSE: There is an existing access into the site, that regardless of ownership, is used and is considered safe in highway safety terms.

THE RECOMMENDATION REMAINS UNCHANGED
