28. MAIDSTONE TRANSPORT STRATEGY

The Board considered the report of Kent Highway Services and Maidstone Borough Council regarding the Transport Strategy as part of the Core Strategy consultation.

Discussion took place around four different areas of the strategy, namely Town Centre, Strategic Housing Development, Strategic Employment Development and Rural Service Centres/Rural Areas.

The Board agreed to submit a list of the key issues to the core strategy consultation.

<u>RESOLVED</u>: That the following comments be submitted as a response to the Core Strategy consultation on the Transport Strategy from the Maidstone Joint Transportation Board:-

- To include the gyratory and possible new cycle/pedestrian crossing over the river
- To review the former bridge gyratory scheme that involved the addition of the northbound A229 on the eastern side of the river
- That a transport interchange at Maidstone East is essential
- To consider the widening of St Peter's Bridge
- To consider the use of the River Medway as a transport option
- To undertake a review of the use of residential roads for parking by workers
- Cycle routes quality of routes is more important that the quantity
- There should be a careful dispersal of development within the villages
- When considering where housing development should go, consideration must be given to the effect on freight traffic and other infrastructure issues e.g. sewerage and pollution
- The 80/20 split should be reviewed again
- The number of housing allocations for North West Maidstone should be reduced
- There must be recognition of the need for developers to contribute towards the road infrastructure
- The housing development should follow the existing and potential infrastructure
- There should be a good mix of employment opportunities
- The South East Maidstone Strategic Link would assist the regeneration of Park Wood Industrial site
- Consideration of Detling Airfield as a potential employment site

- The need to ensure rail services are kept in the Rural Service Centres
- A higher speed internet connection for villages will help to reduce travel as more people will be able to work from home

Update on Petitions submitted to Kent Highway Services

A report by the Head of Transport & Development to the Joint Transportation Board

Summary

1. A report to update the Board on the current status of petitions received by Kent Highway Services (KHS).

Traffic Calming Measures, Heath Road, Coxheath

- 2. A petition was submitted in April 2008 by 59 residents, lead by Mr A R Monk of Westerhill Road, Coxheath. It sought action to improve the traffic calming measures installed along Heath Road, Coxheath as the petitioners felt these were dangerous.
- 3. A number of changes have been carried out to the traffic calming since the submission of this petition and as previously reported KHS had agreed to carry out a review of the safety record in Coxheath, further speed checks and complete the safety audit of the current scheme. This work has been completed and sent to the both the County Councillor and Parish Council. The Parish Council have recently held an exhibition to consult the community of Coxheath on alternative proposals put forward by their independent consultants prior to further discussions with Kent County Council.
- 4. Arrangements are currently being undertaken by the Cabinet Member in organising a meeting with Coxheath Parish Council to discuss a way forward.

Request for the Implementation of a Weight Restriction through Yalding

- **5.** A petition was submitted in September 2008 by Yalding Parish Council with over 570 signatures supporting a previous request for a weight restriction through Yalding and that surveys of lorry movements through Yalding and East Farleigh be undertaken.
- 6. It was reported at the last meeting of this Board that surveys, paid for by the local County Councillor and Parish Council, had been carried out in November 2010. KHS received the results of these surveys in February 2011 and have subsequently circulated these to the relevant Councillors and Parish Councils. Once the Councillors and Parish Councils have had opportunity to consider these results further discussions will be held with the local community on the way forward. A verbal update on the Freight Action Plan for Kent will be given at the meeting.

Closure of Pheasant Lane, Maidstone South

- 7. A petition was submitted in August 2008 by some 120 residents, lead by Mr David Frais of Osborne House, Loose Road of the Pheasant Lane Action Group which sought the closure of Pheasant Lane to vehicles other than for residential access. The petitioners felt the lane was being used as a rat run, was too narrow for the volume of traffic has too many blind bends with drivers driving too fast and pedestrians are at great risk.
- 8. At the last meeting of this Board the permanent closure of Pheasant Lane to all through traffic was approved. The process to make the initial Experimental Traffic Regulation Order permanent has been initiated. The existing arrangement of preventing through traffic by removable plastic bollards has not proved durable and has now become a maintenance problem. KHS have investigated more robust options and are working with manufacturers on a design which should restrict motor vehicles, but remains accessible

for disabled users and cyclists and importantly, can be removed quickly should emergency access be required.

- **9.** Kent Highway Services are in the process of installing fixed restrictions together with connecting electricity supply to existing signage at each end of Pheasant Lane. Works are ready to be passed over to new contractor for implementation.
- **10.** Kent County Council Highway Services has made the temporary order permanent, the order has come into effect since October 17th 2011. Permanent measures have been ordered to replace the temporary street furniture; these measures are due to be installed by the end of October 2011.

Parking Issues Tudor Avenue

- **11.** It has been reported to previous meetings of this Board that KHS had been passed a petition with 54 signatures from the residents of Tudor Avenue, Maidstone requesting parking restrictions be implemented to deal with commuter parking that the residents feel is causing potential road safety problems.
- **12.** It was proposed that KHS would advertise a Traffic Regulation Order giving notice of the intention to install double yellow lines at certain points along Tudor Avenue to improve road safety on the 26th January 2011. However, due to staff sickness and shortages it has not been possible to progress this Order and KHS are now procuring additional resources and expertise to overcome this problem. Once these resources are in place this Order will be progressed as a priority.
- **13.** Kent Highway Services are now in a position to progress the Order. However, due to limited funding being allocated to safety related parking restrictions, officers are batching requests with the view to advertise different locations within Maidstone under a single Traffic Order. This is to provide efficiency and a more cost effective way of managing funds.
- 14. Due to the timescales, Cllr Chittenden has agreed to fund the said restrictions with additional measures through his Member Highway Fund. The said Traffic Order is to be advertised in November 2011 together with other locations through Cllr Chittenden's MHF process.

Sutton Road Service Road

- **15.** KHS received a petition supported by 55 out of the 66 residents in Sutton Road service road raising concerns over the volume and speed of traffic using the service road to avoid the traffic signals on the A274. At the last meeting of this board it was reported that the local County Councillor, if supported by local residents, would look to use their Member Highway Fund to turn the service road into a cul-de-sac by the use of removable bollards at one end of the road.
- **16.** KHS have consulted the residents of Sutton Road service road seeking their views on whether the support a formal closure and if so at which location. The consultation closes on the 12th April and a verbal update of the results will be given at the meeting.
- **17.** Due to the results of the consultation, Cllr Cooke has chose not to progress with the works through the Member Highway Fund process at the present time.

The withdrawal of the Arriva 101 Service from Bus Stops at Cobtree Golf Course and Salisbury Road, Kits Coty

- **18.** It has been previously reported to this Board that a petition had been received calling for the reinstatement of the 101 bus service to the Cobtree Golf Course Bus Stop and a report was submitted proposing a number of options and seeking Members views.
- **19.** It was agreed that further quotes be obtained for Option 2 in an attempt to reduce the costs of this preferred option. These quotes were returned to KHS and passed to Paul Carter, the local County Councillor, for consideration for funding. Cllr Carter has now approved funding for the scheme from his Member Highway Fund budget and the works are now being programmed with the contractor.

Postley Road, Maidstone

- **20.** A petition has been received from the residents of Postley Road, Maidstone which raises concern over the dangerous and increasingly unacceptable use of the road by buses including speeding. Kent Highway Services have meet with the lead petitioner and are investigating the issues raised by the petitioners. KHS are currently arranging a meeting with the local Councillors to discuss a way forward with respect to this petition.
- **21.** The above meeting was held between local Councillors and it has been agreed that Postley Road will be proposed as part of the Speed Reduction pilot project with measures to be implemented to reduce vehicular speed on Postley Road.

Boxley Road and Beechen Bank Road

- **22.** At the a previous meeting of this Board a petition was received requesting a reduction in the speed limit along Boxley Road and Beechen Bank Road. KHS commissioned a speed survey and have now received the results from its consultants and have reviewed the personal injury crash records along Boxley & Beechen Bank Road. KHS are currently arranging a meeting with the local Councillors and Parish Council to discuss a way forward with respect to this petition.
- **23.** A meeting was held between Officers, Boxley Parish Council and Cllr Carter regarding speed limits along the above-mentioned roads. The results of the surveys showed that the existing speed limit could be reduced and Boxley Parish Council are liaising with officers regarding funding for these works.

Footpath along Lenham Road to Sports Field, Kingswood

- 24. At the last meeting of this board a petition was submitted by Broomfield & Kingswood Parish Council signed by 101 residents requesting a footpath be constructed along the Lenham Road, Kingswood to ensure the safety and well being of pedestrians accessing the Sports Field and its facilities.
- **25.** Early investigations revealed that third party land not in the control of the Highway Authority will be required to construct the footway and excluding land costs the footway could cost in the region of £40,000 to £50,000. KHS have written to the land owners in control of the land to ascertain, if funding was available, whether they would be willing to agree in principle to transfer the land to KHS.
- **26.** Kent Highway Services decided to undertake a formal consultation with residents of Lenham Road seeking views of dedicating private land into the publicly maintainable highway in order to safely install the new footway. Due to objections from residents

subsequent to the consultation, Kent Highway Services are not pursuing with the scheme at the present time.

27. This scheme is being progressed by Cllr Whittle in partnership with Broomfield and Kingswood Parish Council through the Member Highway Fund process. Cllr Whittle has agreed to fund designs costs and which will enable the Parish Council to decide whether to fund the works.

Speed limit Reduction - Charlton Lane, West Farleigh

- **28.** At the previous meeting of this Board, the Chairman of West Farleigh Parish Council, presented a petition requesting a reduction in the speed limit on Charlton Lane, West Farleigh from 60 mph to 30 mph for the safety and protection of all residents and road users.
- **29.** At the meeting it was confirmed that Cllr Stockell had agreed to fund the cost of the reduced speed limit in Charlton Lane from her Member Highway Fund and that KCC will be proceeding on that basis. A Traffic Regulation Order to reduce the speed limit will be produced and future updates will be included in the Member Highway Fund Update report.

Speed Limit Reduction in Sheephurst Lane, Collier Street

- **30.** Kent Highway Services have received a petition from residents of Sheephurst Lane requesting that the current speed limit is reduced. The petition has 68 signatures supporting a change in the existing speed limit. There have been no reported personal injury crashes over the last 3 year period as a resultant of speeding.
- **31.** Kent Highway Services will investigate the request from the lead petitioner with the view to provide an update at the next Joint Transportation Board.
- **32.** The safety record along this route has been investigated. The analysis of the personal injury crashes on Sheephurst Lane does not demonstrate that a lower speed limit would provide a quantifiable crash saving and does not meet with the intervention level set by the County Council therefore, funding would not be available via the Casualty Reduction Programme. KHS will discuss these findings with the local Member to see whether any alternative measures could be provided via the Member Highway Fund.

New Petitions

Speed Limit Reduction in Green Lane, Collier Street

- **33.** Kent County Council Highway Services has received a petition from residents of Green Lane Cottages, Green Lane, requesting that the current speed limit is reduced. The petition has 7 signatures supporting a change in the existing speed limit. There have been no reported personal injury crashes over the last 3 year period as a resultant of speeding.
- **34.** Kent Highway Services will investigate the request from the lead petitioner with the view to provide an update at the next Joint Transportation Board.

Update on 20MPH Zones in Maidstone

- **35.** Kent County Council Highway Services are in the process of installing the said measures at locations previously agreed. Surveys are currently being undertaken onsite identifying the existing vehicle speeds in the vicinity of the schools.
- **36.** Designs are currently being drafted at selected locations with the view to install the measures in 2012. Kent County Council will be working with Schools trying to reduce any congestion during the construction phase.
- **37.** County Councillors responsible for the works will be consulted on initial designs once made available.

Winter Damage Repairs – Find & Fix Completion Update

A report by the Director of Kent County Council Highways & Transportation to the Joint Transportation Board.

1.1 Summary

- 1.1.1 The 'find and fix' works programme commenced in May 2011 and was completed on 31 August 2011, following the award of contract to Mason Civil Engineering for the Maidstone area.
- 1.1.2 With the programme this year we gave greater control to the Maidstone Highways Team for identification and prioritising works. This has enabled the teams to target specific areas and drive productivity.
- 1.1.3 During the Period from 1st May until 31 August; I am able to report that 115 roads were completed. This has been broken down to 538 potholes and 9,544m2 of patching for the Maidstone area. The completed locations are listed below for the Boards information.

1 <u>NEW STAFFING ARRANGEMENTS IN KENT HIGHWAYS AND</u> <u>TRANSPORTATION</u>

As a part of the County Council's strategy, Bold Steps for Kent, and wider national legislation and budget reductions, there have been changes across Kent County Council. This includes the work done in Kent Highway Services now called Kent Highways and Transportation (KH&T). structure of Kent Highway Services & Transportation.

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 As a part of the County Council's strategy, Bold Steps for Kent, and wider national legislation and budget reductions, there have been changes across Kent County Council. This includes the work done in Kent Highway Services now called Kent Highways and Transportation (KH&T). This report sets out recent changes following a restructure of the department and highlights how KH&T will continue to focus on working with communities and ensure proper engagement with Members, Councillors, Parishes and local people.
- 1.1.2 As a part of the county council's strategy, Bold Steps for Kent, and wider legislation around community engagement, the way KCC works is changing with an aim to improve all the services provided by the council and to enhance the service offered to communities in Kent.
- 1.1.3 Kent Highways and Transportation (KH&T) formerly called Kent Highway Services - will continue to focus on working with communities and are committed to proper engagement with Members, district councils, parishes and local people. In order to strengthen this area, meet the budget savings requirements and bring

about efficiencies and effectiveness, changes have been made to the staffing of the department. This follows a two phased restructuring process.

1.2 New structure

- 1.2.1 Prior to the restructure each district had allocated contacts within the Highway Operations teams, namely Highway Inspectors and Community Liaison Officers. From 1 July the new structure came into force and there are no longer community Liaison Officers. Instead we now have **Highway Stewards** and statutory Highway Inspectors. The Highway Stewards have been allocated to a specific area and they will deal with customer service enquiries, Member, parish and community contact. They have been empowered to carry out small maintenance jobs on site to rectify minor issues such as clearing round a sign / clearing a gully grate. In addition they will identify specific jobs that are deemed necessary for their area, which will be processed through our Highway Management Centre (HMC) at Aylesford. The process of the jobs can be prioritised and programmed in a timely manner with the designated team in the HMC, allowing the public facing staff to spend more time in the area, dealing with service requests. They will undertake parish visits, as agreed locally and will be working out in the community on a daily basis. The Parishes / Members and the general public should still be report defects via the web site or our contact centre to ensure that they are recorded and entered into our system to be processed.
- 1.2.2 Highway Inspectors will continue to carry out statutory inspections and will highlight defects and ensure that these are repaired within the prescribed time periods. Inspectors and stewards will be supported by an efficient HMC which is situated on the first floor of our Aylesford Highway Depot.
- 1.2.3 A list of key staff for this district is attached at **Appendix 1**.

1.3 Conclusion and Recommendation

1.3.1 KH&T is committed to providing a high quality service to the communities in Kent. The recent changes will ensure that, despite budget reductions and other challenges, KH&T will keep a focus on community engagement. Members of this Joint Transportation Board are asked to note this report.

1. KCC policy statement and plan

This will be the document approved by Environment Highways and Waste policy Overview Committee.

2. Winter service procedure

During normal working hours the District Manager will deal with all winter service matters, including managing local action in snow/ice emergencies. The Duty Officer (DO) will assume control out of hours. District Manager (DM) will also ensure that adequate support is provided to DO out of hours in emergency situations and that a suitable handover briefing takes place at the start and end of the normal working day. See Appendix 1 for personnel roles in winter service.

- 2.1 The Duty Officer will commence duty at 17.00 hours on Monday until 09.00 the following Monday and will be responsible for all the actions below. Assistance will be given but the ultimate responsibility will be with the DO.
- 2.2 Immediately after 1400 hours daily the weather forecast/information will be available on email/telephone on 01622-XXXXXX. (Update forecasts may be available at 21.30 hours each day, or when issued.)
- 2.3 **Instructing and recording actions** –The DO will record action taken on the Winter Service action sheet (attached as Appendix 2). Email to Enterprise; this will instruct them of the action that is needed. Provide as much detail as possible on the form. In the event that additional actions are needed, confirm by phone with the Enterprise Duty Supervisor. If, in the opinion of the duty officer, or on a site check, different action is taken to that recommended by the Winter Duty Officer (WDO), please inform the WDO. Enterprise will be informed directly of the main action. Duty Officer will decide and instruct on any other action needed.

The winter service action sheet should also be copied by email to the relevant Priority Response Officer, District Manager and Highway Manager.

The PRO will ensure that a WAMS order is raised as soon as practicable. The PRO will save the form in the designated folder on the KCC IT system.

- 2.4 At weekends/bank holidays the winter forecast/action will be sent out at 14.00 hours or soon thereafter. In the event that a forecast is not received the DO will phone the KCC forecast on 01622-XXXXXX to receive forecast and instructions.
- 2.5 If there are any changes, i.e. rain, contact the Enterprise Winter Duty Supervisor as soon as possible to cancel/ amend the instruction and inform the WDO
- 2.5 A snow/ice emergency can only be declared by a Highway Manager (HM). In the event of a snow/ice emergency being declared by the HM, strategic action should considered, i.e. opening an Emergency Room and calling in other staff etc.
- 2.6 In a declared snow emergency the priorities are primary routes, secondary routes, recorded snow clearance priorities and finally anything reported by the public etc. All public reports are to be logged on the agreed spreadsheet (Appendix 3) This will usually be completed by the community liaison team who will also ensure that these enquiries are entered into the WAMS system and followed up accordingly.

8. Snow clearance priorities, with details by town/area in priority order

In the event of snow or ice, Maidstone will bring into effect its Local Winter Service Plan with staffing levels appropriate to the emergency. Pre-planned salting or emergency salting on precautionary salting routes shall be carried out as required and in accordance with the Winter Service Plan.

Highway Managers shall manage the response for dealing with ice / snow on links to urban centres, villages and hamlets beyond the primary or secondary precautionary salting route network, with priority given to bus routes. Consideration will be given to links to schools (in term time), stations, medical centres, doctors surgeries, old peoples homes, cemeteries, crematoria and industrial, commercial and shopping centres. Below is the Maidstone priority list of key areas that will be considered during an emergency.

Pavements

During snow days arrangements will be made to clear pavements in key town centre and other areas as identified and agreed by district council and KCC staff. The prioritised pavements/footways are identified in this document.

Maidstone is also able to store a quantity of salt / sand at their Bircholt Depot at Parkwood. If Maidstone Borough do not suspend their service and there is snow / ice clearing to be undertaken, then KCC will provide cover for this period – working to the priority list or as directed by the District Manager.

A plan has been drawn up for Maidstone Town Centre footways listing the priorities and the areas Maidstone Borough Council will cover in the event of a snow emergency. In addition a number of the key shopping areas outside the town centre may be covered by Maidstone Borough (Maidstone looking at agreements). 

Personnel Roles

Winter Duty Officer (WDO) is the KCC officer who receives weather forecasts and decides the appropriate salting actions.

Enterprise Winter Duty Supervisor (EWDS) is the Enterprise officer who arranges the Enterprise out of hours WS actions

Highway Manager (HM) will declare a snow/ice emergency when appropriate

District Managers will co-ordinate action during normal office hours in conjunction with the WDO and where necessary the relevant HM
