Notice has been given pursuant to Executive Procedure Rule 2.6 of the intention to present a petition in the following terms:

I/We the undersigned deplore Maidstone Council's plans for a 25% increase in the number of houses in Coxheath in the next 17 years – which threatens to change our cherished Greensand Ridge Village into a southern suburb of Maidstone, overwhelm local infrastructure, destroy farmland, wildlife and generate an average of 2,700 extra car trips every single day.

I/We further call upon Maidstone Council to recognise the constraints to growth at Coxheath and ensure delivery of levels and types of housing and employment provision which will respond to local population trends and needs.
