During the consideration of the budget on 27 February 2015 the Council approved the use of 50% of the additional income achieved in 2014/15 from environmental enforcement litter fines to be directed to litter awareness education work with children and young adults. As the Council has previously agreed that the money should be ring fenced to street cleaning services is proposed that the remaining 50% be utilised to purchase this equipment.
