Trustee Appointment to the Relief in Need Charities

1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Relief in Need Charities provide grants to individuals and organisations who are in need, hardship or distress.
 - 1.2 Residents of the former Borough of Maidstone, as constituted prior to the local government reorganisation in 1974, are eligible to seek support.
 - 1.3 There is currently one vacancy for a trustee, and another of the trustee's membership will expire in March 2022. Any Member can apply for these positions.
 - 1.4 The Trustees are appointed by the Democracy and General Purposes Committee for a term of 4 years, and Councillor Daley has expressed an interest on continuing his term after it expires in March 2022.
