1. URGENT DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE EXECUTIVE

1.1 CABINET MEMBER FOR REGENERATION

1.1.1 The Cabinet Member for Regeneration agreed on 17 September 2010 that the decision set out below was urgent and needed to be actioned within the call-in period. The reason for urgency was because the site list had to be submitted to the HCA by 22 September for onward submission to Central Government.
