1. Introduction

2. Recommendation

 - Its delivery of effective scrutiny principles; and
 - The suggested co-optees and expert witnesses.

3. Reasons for Recommendation

- 3.1 The Committee has created a work programme for the next municipal year. At their fist meeting held on 1 June 2011 Members resolved that:
 - Traffic Congestion and Transport and Employment and Skills should be the Committee's two main reviews for the year; and
 - Subject to the availability and timescales of the transport review,
 Tourism should be a smaller review, investigating ways of generating income and revenue within the borough
