# Additional Funding – Surfacing Sites - Update Information

A report by the Director of Kent Highway Services to the Joint Transportation Board.

### 1.1 Summary

- 1.1.1 As part of the Government settlement following the weather damage, KHS has identified an additional £4,500,000.00 of funding for surface treatments across the County. Roads have been identified where there was a need to seal the surface following patching works, previous find & fix or local knowledge of specific areas in need of attention.
- 1.1.2 The roads originally identified for Maidstone are listed below with the surface treatment, for the Board's information.
