
Where is the work taking place?





Phase one

The project will begin with the temporary closure of Knightrider Street and the suspension of the one-way order from Stone Street to Mill Street. Some work will also take place in Lower Stone Street, including a new main from Knightrider Street across the junction into Mote Road. Traffic will be diverted via the one-way system. Access to Knightrider Street for residents and businesses will be via Brunswick Street and Priory Road – there will be no through route to Mill Street.

PHASE 2 Full road closure Temporary/night road closure

Phase Two

Knightrider Street will reopen, with operations moving into Lower Stone Street, Romney Place and Hayle Road. A temporary closure of Romney Place at its junction with Lower Stone Street will be necessary to allow work in the junction – traffic will be diverted via Mote Road. Night-time closures of Lower Stone Street may be necessary. In Hayle Road and Postley Road, work will be carried out with a lane closure.



Phase Three

Work in Upper Stone Street will be carried out with a lane closure – for some connections to side roads, night closures will be necessary. Side roads will also be closed at their junction with Upper Stone Street to allow connections to be made. Signs will be in place to indicate diversion routes. The one-way order in Campbell Road will be suspended to allow access.
