- » to **remove kerb upstands** and existing tarmac surfaces
- » to introduce a **flush** and consistent granite surface throughout
- » to provide more opportunities to rest along the street with new benches
- » to contribute to the greening of the street by planting new trees
- » to enhance the street by night with functional and decorative lighting
- » to **retain** the existing access arrangements and loading restrictions
- » to replace the bollards that premanently close off Brewer & Union Streets
